

The Delivering Housing Growth project, partly funded by the Humber LEP's Local Growth Fund, covered 6 areas of housing development works in Hull; Ganstead, Portobello, Southcoates, Maybury, Milldane and Ings. On the back of this, the project at Ings phase 3B was shortlisted for Local Authority Building Control National Award, under the category of Best Large New Housing Development.

They highlight innovative and creative solutions and building control professionalism that leads to safe, sustainable and high quality construction projects. And whilst being beaten to post on the night, the 'Ings phase 3B' project was assessed against the following criteria; adhering to Building Regulations, performance and sustainability, working relationships, site and project management, innovation and problem solving and overall outcomes.
