

HETA has now completed their move into a new headquarters as part of an investment programme worth around £4.5-million. HETA has been supported in the move by Hull City Council's Economic Regeneration team and by the Humber Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP), which secured £1.3-million from the Local Growth Fund through the Northern Powerhouse.

The business relocated its entire Hull operation into the Advanced Engineering Training Centre on Dansom Lane, Hull, welcoming the first learners into the new facility on Monday 10 September. There are essentially two aspects to HETA's business model- upskilling of people already in the workforce and the recruitment and training of apprentices who are about to enter the labour market. HETA believe that their current model of employer engagement and training delivery has value in selected international markets with particular emphasis on working with existing local partners to deliver training and provide technical expertise on capacity building projects.

With the above in mind and with an understanding that employer engagement is vital to their success they held an 'Employer Open Day' on Wednesday 10th October where local employer had the opportunity to find out more about what services HETA provides to the young people, how they support the employers and apprentices through their journey and how taking on an apprentice can help them, all whilst experiencing first-hand the new facilities within the training centre.

The event was well attended resulting in around half of the first-year apprentices having already secured sponsorship from employers and HETA's staffs are working flat out to find places for the rest. The company has an employment success rate of 97 per cent, and every apprentice from 2017-2018 has found a job.
