Courage

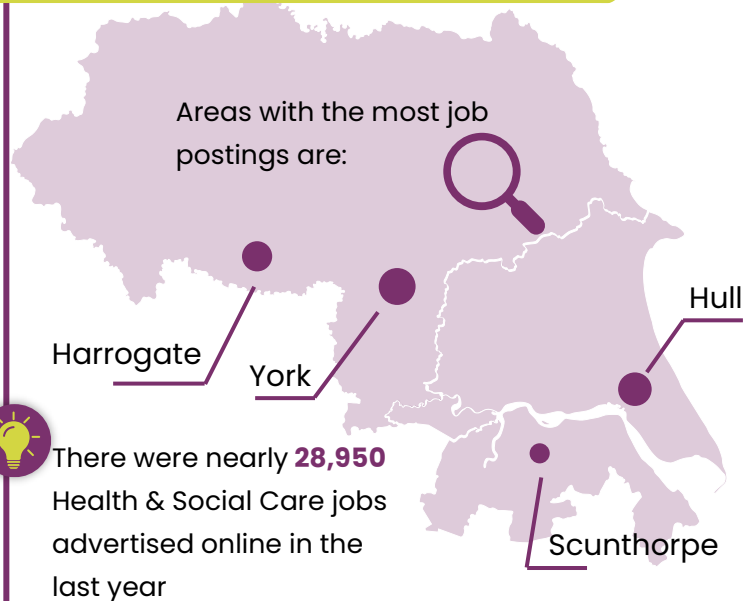
